Guidelines for debunking

- Tracing the source & its reliability
- No assumptions!
- Your language:
 - should not have any negativity.
 - No strong or harsh words.
 - No bias, should try to be very neutral.
- Google it!
- Reverse image search.

DEBUNKING FAKE NEWS

Sourcing the Fake News; Debunking Methods & Tools

- Finding source of the message/news backtrack to the URL. (best option: Google)
- Techniques & Tools:
 - Text News directly Google the news, intelligently, to get the source
 - Photos:
 - Google Reverse image options
 - Google "Visually Similar Images"
 - Also check on http://www.tineye.com look for oldest.

Videos:

- Checking for suspect parameters low res., shaky, location, situation, etc.
- Google screenshots
