## Youth Parliament on Lokpal held

At a Youth Parliament organised on Sunday on the Lokpal Bill aimed at encouraging participation of youngsters, a memorandum with five clauses was prepared that could be introduced in the Bill in the best interests of the citizens. These 5 clauses, put forward by college students and young corporates, included \_\_ excluding the PM out of the Lokpal ambit unless he/she evicts the office, Lokayuktas to be under the control of Lokpal committee, inclusion of corporate sector under Lokayukta, judiciary to be under a Judicial Commission to be set up through legislation and Lokpal to have its own investigation wing. Five participants selected on Sunday would submit the memorandum to parliamentarians in New Delhi, appealing to them for inclusion in the Lokpal Bill.
