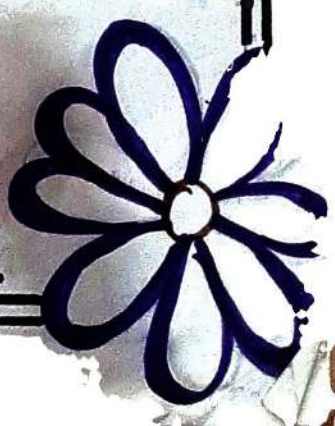
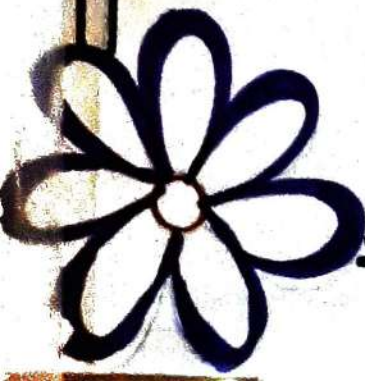

Topic: Problem Faced By Parents in Education children

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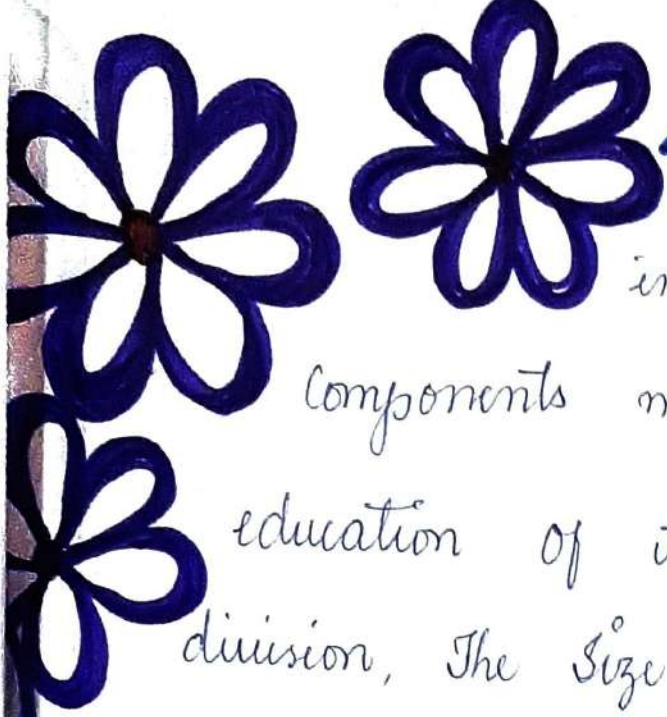
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Introduction

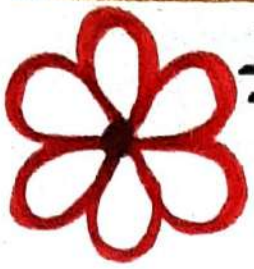
Communication Should Be two Way...

⇒ Decisions making such as including parents in school work decisions, developing parents leaders and representatives.

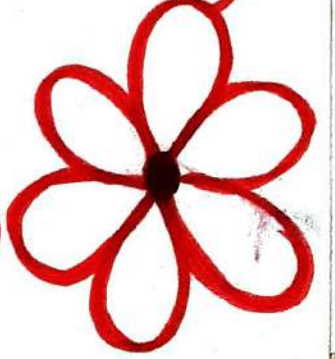
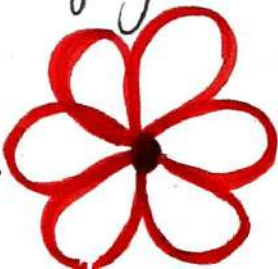
