

- * In many countries, public service is viewed as a crucial component of a healthy and functioning society, and governments may provide incentives or support to encourage individuals to pursue public service careers.



* A public service is a resource offered by an organization, typically a government agency or private business, intended to support members of a community.


Public services include health care, waste removal and transportation, and are systems and solutions that can benefit various groups of individuals.

Energy is one of the most important services that government agencies provide.

It ensures that citizens have the ability to heat, cool and light their homes, power their appliances and complete tasks more efficiently.

The most common energy service that governments provide is electricity, which they may produce in fossil fuel, hydroelectric or nuclear plants or through wind and solar powered processes.

LAW ENFORCEMENT

Law enforcement is a common public service that many governments provide at the local and national levels. The primary goals of law enforcement are to protect citizens from criminal activity, prevent future crimes, conduct criminal investigations and penalize criminal offenders. In order to accomplish these goals, governments organize law enforcement agencies for different jurisdictions. Most law enforcement agencies exist at the municipal or county level, although some serve entire countries and work to combat large-scale criminal threats.

How did Hyderabad tackle the water problem?

Pavleen Begum Said that In its first term, the TRS government took up a Rs 2,000 crore drinking water Scheme in all municipalities and corporations around Hyderabad. The first phase of the ORR drinking water the foundation stone was laid on Monday for the second phase at Rs 1,200 crore.

CASE 2:

who are eligible for free water in Hyderabad?

Ghouse Bhai Said that In a step to fulfil 1 Poll - promise in Telangana, the State government is providing "free" water supply to all domestic consumers up to 20,000 liters [20 KL]. Domestic slum, Domestic Individual, Domestic - Multi storied Building (MSB) / Bulk Connections are eligible for 20 KL [20,000 litres] free water supply.

CASE 3:

Are the municipality allowed to cut off your electricity?

Mahmooda Begum Said that The Municipality is legally obligated to give a notice to the person responsible for the account, A minimum of 14 days written notice of termination is required for water and electricity accounts in arrears and if the notice period is shorter than 14 days, or not Supplied, the disconnection is illegal.

CASE 4:

What happens if you don't pay municipal rates?

Abdul Kareem Said that Termination of electricity Supply by a municipality. Accordingly. a municipality may terminate the Supply of electricity as a result of arrear rates and taxes. This may be the position even if the electricity account up to date.

What is the problem about garbage?

Bashir Ahmed said that Burying garbage also causes both air and water pollution, and simply transporting it to the sites consumes an increasing amount of valuable fossil fuels, which produces more pollution and other problems. Burial in a Landfill, the typical plastic trash bag takes 1,000 years to degrade, giving off ~~toxig~~ as it does.

CASE 6:

What is the biggest problem with garbage?

Mohd Abdul Jameel Pollution of Soil: waste can leak hazardous chemicals into the soil and from there into our food. Air pollution: the burying of waste at landfills release toxic substances into the air, including extremely poisonous ~~dioxin~~. Pollution of oceans: 13 million tonnes of plastic end up in the world's oceans each year.

Abubaker said that there are many reasons for the production of garbage. One reason for this growing urbanization and prosperity. How does garbage damage the environment?



Most of the area is covered with dirty Garbage and bad smell NO proper Dust bins , MCH workers are not coming regularly . They come Twice in a week. Large Roads and streets areas are contaminated with Garbage like fast garbage, vegetable garbage and dead animal bodies , ~~etc~~ Hazardous waste like plastics etc.

Contaminated water and poor Sanitation are linked to transmission of diseases such cholera, diarrhoea, dysentery, hepatitis A, typhoid and polio. Absent, inadequate, or inappropriately managed water and Sanitary Services expose individuals to preventable health risks.
