
- ⇒ Recycling is a part of waste disposal hierarchy reduce, reuse, recycle.

- ⇒ 24 trees are cut down to make 1 ton of news papers.


- ⇒ 24 trees are cut down to make 1 ton of newspapers

- ⇒ Recycling one ton of plastic can save up to 1,000 - 2,000 gallons of gasoline.
- ⇒ Recycling one glass bottle saves enough energy to power a 100 watt bulb for four hours.
- ⇒ Due to the fact that people aren't recycling as much as they should, the rainforests are actually being cut down by about 100 acres a minute.

of the soda can




with sharp scissors.

that you like










How to make

a card board box


1 starting with take


## Action undertaken
