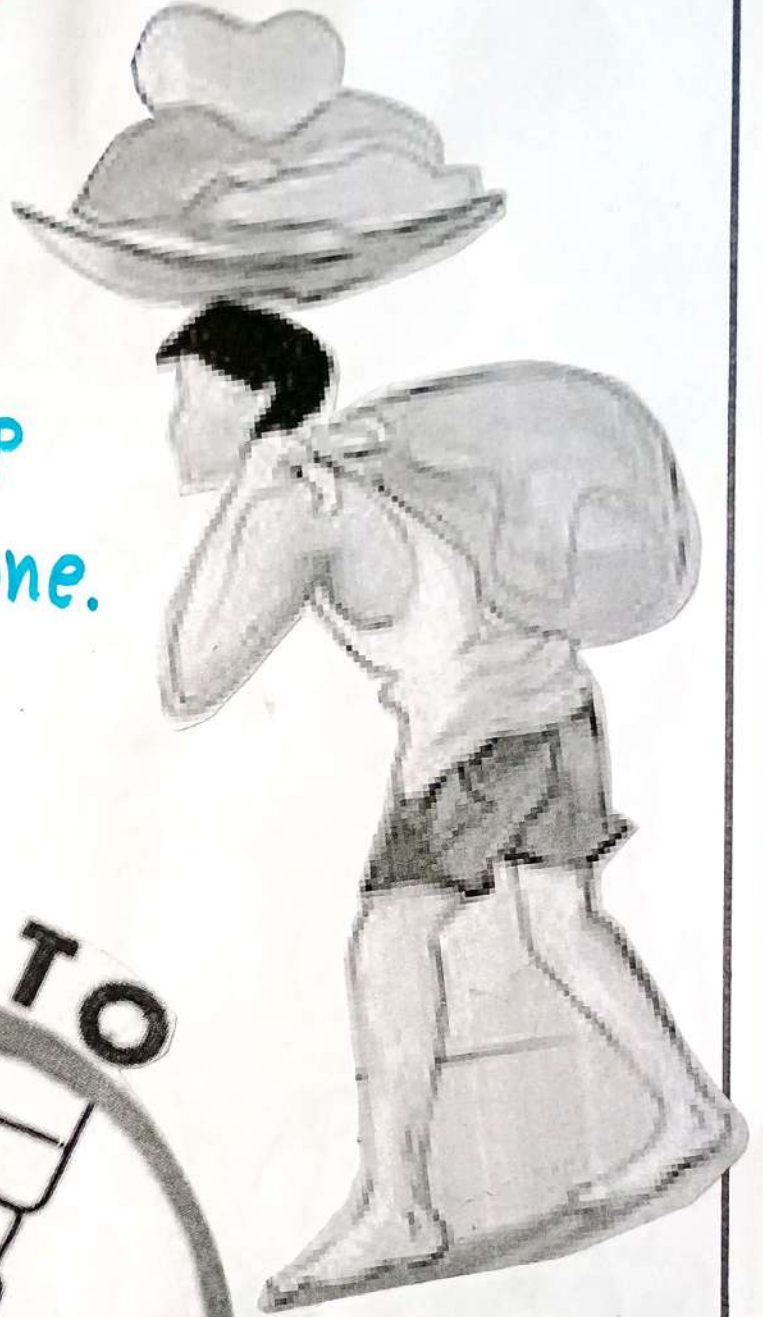

Now in India there are many children who are working like a labour, the parents are forcing for work, who don't have parents another person is forcing them to do work in shops, hotels, in constructions etc. India is a signatory to the Convention on the Rights of the child. Thus India is obliged to protect the Rights of children. Some of them are :-

- 1] The Right to Survival :- which includes the Right to life, health, nutrition and adequate standards of living.
- 2] The Right to protection :- which includes the freedom from all forms of exploitation, abuse, in human or degrading treatment and neglect.
- 3] The Rights to Development :- which includes the Rights of

Education, Support for early childhood development and care, Social Security and the Rights to leisure, recreation and cultural activities.

4] The Right to participation :- which includes respect for the views of the child freedom of Expression, access to appropriate information and freedom to thought, conscience and religion in

India has made some significant laws for children such as :-

The children [pledging of labour] Act, 1933 aims at eradicating the evil of pledging the labour of young children by their parents.

The Factories Act, 1948 provides that children shall not be required or allowed to work in any factory.

Q) With whom do you live?

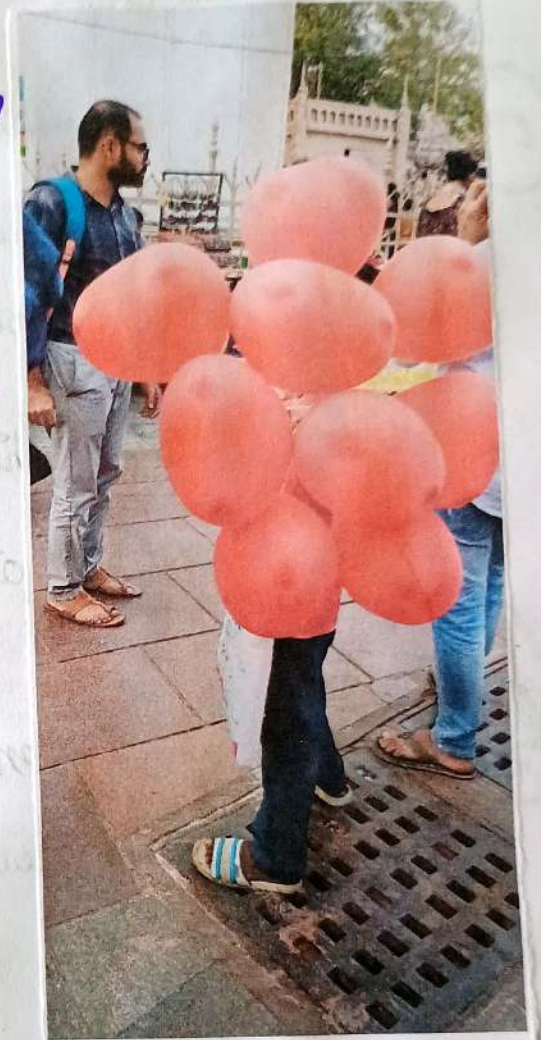
A) I live with my Parents

- * One person is already tryed about it to stop child labour. because of a girl who died before 2 years. he believed that Government will take action but no response was observed.
- * A person is doing so much hard work to stop child labour. that he is spreading the news about many schools to bring awareness to stop child labour.

Recommendation for Solution

To solve this problem of child labour we can use following solutions:-

Bring awareness in our society.

If you know any child labourers family you can go and convince them to stop child labour.

Motivate them for education.

Try to talk with them and try to solve their problems.

Distribute pamphlets or posters in your locality to

spread awareness.

Collect money from neighbours, teachers and parents and send a child labourer to school.

Spread awareness about the laws made to stop child labour mentioned in our Indian Constitution.
